## **Aviation News: Change in BasicMed Rules**

## **Aviation Quote**

"With a short dash down the runway, the machine lifted into the air and was flying. It was only a flight of twelve seconds, and it was an uncertain, wavy, and creeping sort of flight at best; but it was real flight at last and not a glide."

The FAA is making tweaks to the rules around BasicMed. Previously, any pilot medically certified under BasicMed was unable to function as a required crew member not acting as PIC. This included serving as a safety pilot during simulated instrument flight. Although the most recent changes primarily apply to medical certification for commercial balloon pilots, an amendment in the revised rule now allows required crewmembers such as safety pilots to operate under BasicMed.

The new rule becomes effective on December 22, 2022.


